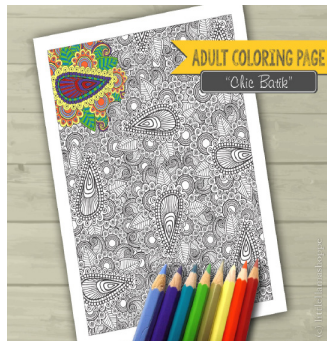

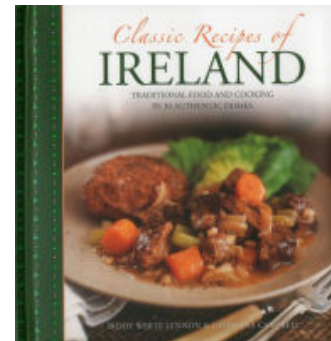
ADULT COLORING Thurs. March 23 — 7pm

WHAT'S COOKING: IRISH DISHES Thurs. March 30 — 7pm

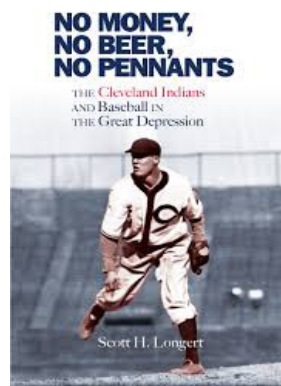
Bring in your favorite Irish dish to share, along with the recipe.
