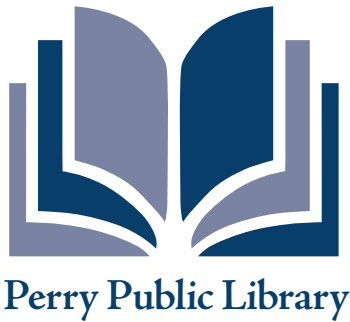

Underground Railroad at Rider's Inn

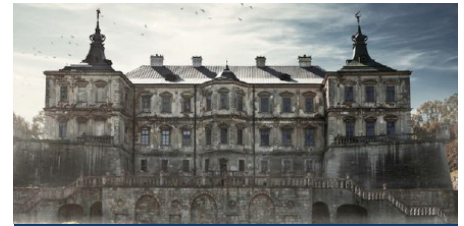
Thurs. June 8 — 7pm

One way the Perry Public Library is doing this is by removing



fines from children's books and materials, like our neighbor Madison Public Library, and lowering fines for other items, like dvds that are no longer new. You will no longer need to worry about a huge bill every time you check out a stack of childrens' books and are late, just make sure to renew or return them before they are marked "lost."
