

Songs and rhymes to share:

Up I Stretch (*actions follow words*)

** sing up and down the scale*

Up I stretch on tippy toe
Down to touch my heels I go
Up again my arms I send
Down again my knees I bend

Up the Hill a Malaysian folk game

(use child's arm as the hill)

Here goes a turtle up the hill
- creepy, creepy, creepy, creepy
Here goes a rabbit up the hill
- boing, boing, boing, boing
Here goes an elephant up the hill
- thud, thud, thud, thud
Here goes a snake up the hill
- slither, slither, slither, slither
Here comes a rock down the hill
- boom, boom, boom, boom

(jump your fist down child's arm)

CRASH! (*land fist in child's open palm*)

Roly Poly

(Roll hands round each other, in direction named)

Roly poly, roly poly, up, up, up,
Roly poly, roly poly, down, down, down;
Roly poly, roly poly, out, out, out,
Roly poly, roly poly, in, in, in, (*give a big hug*)

The Kissing Rhyme (*lift child up and down*)

Up, up, up in the sky like this
Down, down, down, for a great big kiss (*give a kiss*)
Up like this, down for a kiss, (*give another kiss*)
You're a special child! (*give a big hug*)

I'm a little teapot

I'm a little teapot, short and stout,
Here is my handle, (*put hand on hip*)
Here is my spout. (*hold other arm out to side*)
When I get all steamed up, hear me shout!
Tip me over, and pour me out. (*lean to side*)

Teeter Totter (*lift child up and down*)

Up and down, and up and down,
High up in the sky
Up and down, and up and down,
On our teeter totter

Jack in the Box

Jack in the box, (*curl child up*)
Lying so still.
Won't you come out?
Yes I will! (*lift child up / child jumps up*)

The Seesaw (*lift child up and down*)

The seesaw goes up, the seesaw goes down.
Seesaw up, seesaw down.
Seesaw stops, one end on the ground.

Dickery Dare

Dickery, dickery, dare (*bounce child on knees*)
The pig flew up in the air (*lift child up*)
The man in brown soon brought him down
(*bring child down*)
Dickery, dickery dare! (*bounce child on knees*)

The Royal Duke of York

(follow words moving body up or down)

Oh the royal Duke of York
He had ten thousand men
He marched them up to the top of the hill
And marched them down again
And when they're up - they're up
And when they're down - they're down
But when they're only halfway up
They're neither up nor down
- other verses:

They played their pipes to the top of the hill
They beat their drums to the top of the hill...
They waved their flags at the top of the hill...
- Make up your own!

Old Grey Mare

(sing to "row row row your boat")

Clip, clip, clipety clop *(bounce child)*
Clipety, clipety, clop
The old grey mare goes up and down
(lift child up and down)
Until it's time to stop *(stop bouncing)*

Stepping Stones

Stepping over stepping stones,
One, two, three.
Stepping over stepping stones,
Come with me.
The river's very fast,
And the river's very wide,
We'll step across on stepping stones,
And reach the other side.

I'm Climbing

(suit actions to words)

I'm climbing, climbing, up the ladder
Sliding, sliding down the slide
Now I stop with a BUMP!
On my feet...
Up I Jump!

A Little Frog

A little green froggie am I am I
A- Hippity, hippity, hop *(bounce child on knees)*
I can jump in the air sooooo high *(lift child)*
A- Hippity, hippity, hop *(bounce child on knees)*

Grandpa's Knees

The wind blows down the chimney *(bounce gently)*
The wind blows through the trees
The wind blows *(child's name)* up and down *(lift child up)*
Upon her Grandpa's* knees
(change to Mommy or Grandma or Daddy...)

Flying Man

Flying man, flying man *(bounce child on knees)*
Up in the sky *(lift child up)*
Flying man, flying man *(bounce child on knees)*
Flying so high *(lift child up)*
Over the mountains *(bounce child on knees)*
And over the sea *(lift child up)*
Flying man, flying man *(bounce child on knees)*
Won't you take me? *(give big hug)*

My hands upon my head I place

My hands upon my head I place,
On my shoulders, on my face,

(suit actions to words)
