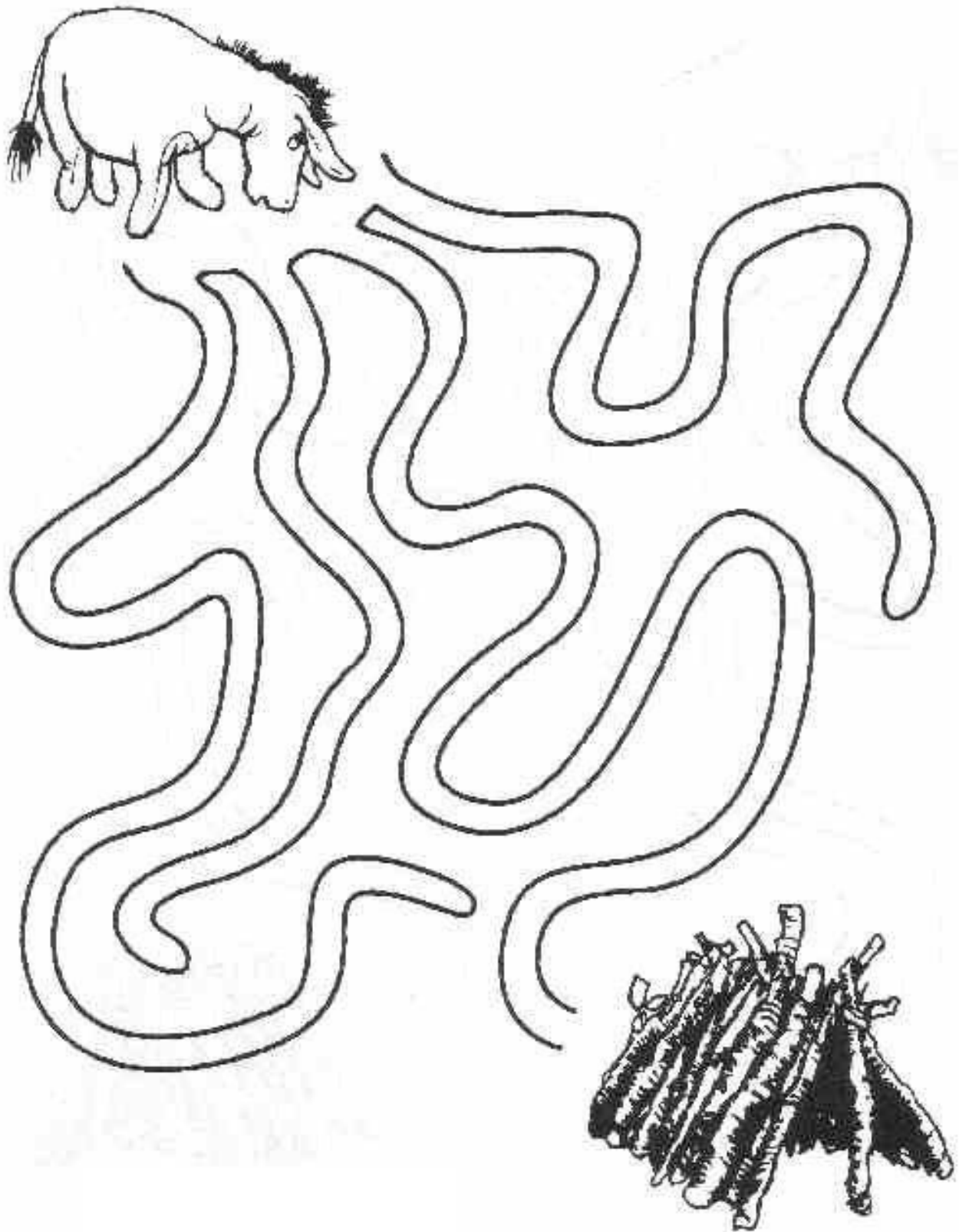

Early Literacy Extras:

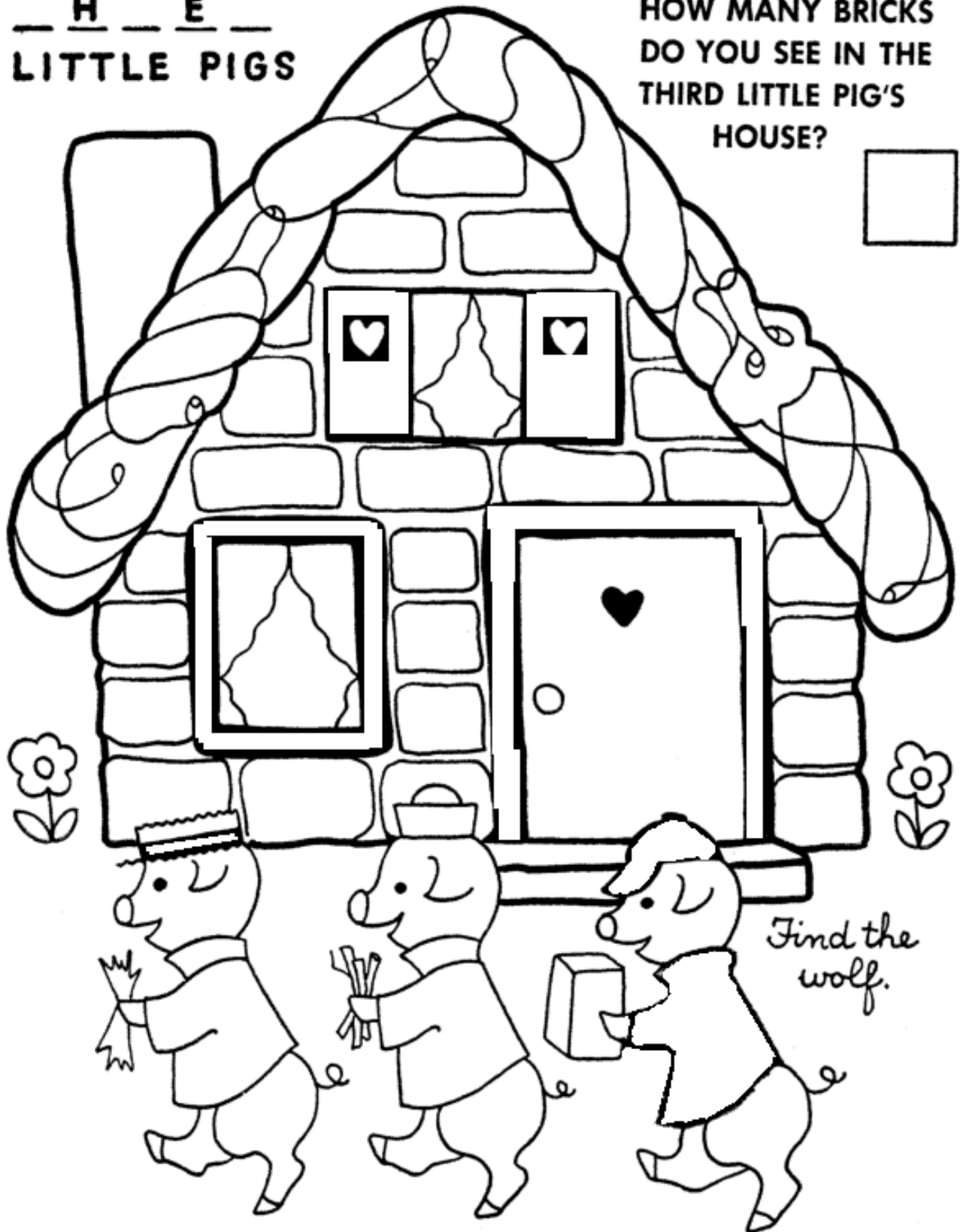
- Talk about the words “home” and “house” and talk about how they have similar and different meanings
- Help your child think of other types of homes that people and animals live in. Learning unusual words is a great way to expand your child’s vocabulary!
- Help your child think of words that rhyme with “house” like “mouse” – make up silly rhymes with these words. Try rhyming “home” too!
- Help your child think of words that start with the “H”- “huh” sound (hat, happy, hiccup, hand)
